

Q1 How have your company's sales trended over the last 90 days?






Q2 What is your business outlook for the next 12 months?








Q4 What are your foundry's sales projections for the next 12 months?








Q6 How do you expect the number of full-time employees in your facility to change over the next 12 months?

Q7 Which of these issues are the top 3 concerns or priorities for your company at this time?





Q9 Which best describes the situation at your foundry? Check all that apply.







Q15 What is the primary metal poured at your foundry?




